1st That the farmers believe that they are a wonderful help in preventing Cattle from going off the road onto the tracks when driving them over the crossings,  
2nd also when Cattle stray from pasture these guards are a great help to keep them from straying unto the tracks and right of way,  
3rd Furthermore the farmers find it very difficult to get a fair settlement from Railway Companies when stock are killed on their right of way
