Town Hall Beachburg
 June 8th 1940-

The Municipal Council of the Corporation
 of the Township of Westmeath met in
 the Town Hall on aforesaid date as a
 Court of Revision,
 all members being present, who
 after taking the customary Oath of
 office, took their seats,
 it was then moved by E. J. Edwards
 seconded by Samuel Young that
 this Council be appointed a
 Court of Revision to revise
 the assessment roll of the
 Municipality for the year 1940
 and that John D. MacLean be
 Chairman of the said Court; (Carried)
 it was then moved by S. Young
 seconded by E. J. Edwards that
 all evidence at this Court of
 Revision be taken under Oath Carried

There were nine appeals in all which were then heard in their proper Order, six of which the assessment being sustained, two were reduced and one not heard, the one which was not heard was William Nelson on a \$25.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ assessment it being received too late, those reduced were Angus McKay reduced \$150.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ and The Canadian National Telegraphs \$102.⁵⁰/₁₀₀ after all appeals were heard it was moved by Albert Gervais seconded by Samuel Young that the Clerk be authorized to make all necessary changes in the 1940 assessment roll as submitted to this Court of Revision carried the changes being made it was then moved by E. J. Edwards seconded by Albert Gervais that the assessment roll as revised be the finally revised assessment roll of this Municipality for the year 1940. Carried it was then moved by Albert Gervais seconded by H. G. Bromley that this Court of Revision do now adjourn - sine die. -
