The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath met in the Town Hall on above date pursuant to adjournment,

all members being present with the Reeve in the Chair, the minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve, all bills and Communications were read and Considered,

moved by E. J. Edwards seconded by Samuel Young that the By Law to Levy rates and Taxes for County, Township, General School, Public and Continuation Schools, Roads, Street Lights, etc for the year 1941 be now introduced and read a first time,

1st That the sum of \$21,035.66 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for County purposes for the year 1941 - at a rate of 11.6 mills on the dollar

2nd That the sum of \$2,752.88 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property in the Township of Westmeath excepting

those in School Sections No 2 and 7 -
at a rate of 2.0 mills on the dollar - for
County pupils - for the year 1941 -

3rd That the sum of 1,820.68 is hereby levied upon
and shall be collected from all rateable
property in the Township of Westmeath for
Township purposes - for the year 1941 - at
a rate of 1.0 mill on the dollar, -

4th That the sum of \$3,641.37 is hereby levied
upon and shall be collected from all
rateable property in the Township of
Westmeath for road purposes - for the
year 1941 - at a rate of 2.0 mills on
the dollar, -

5th That the sum of 1,690.03 - is hereby levied
upon and shall be collected from all
rateable property in School Section No 7
for Debiture purposes - for the year 1941
at a rate of 6.3 mills on the dollar, -

6th That the sum of 9,900.⁰⁰ is hereby levied
upon and shall be collected from all
rateable property of Public School
Supporters in the Township of Westmeath
for General School purposes for the
year 1941 - at a rate of 5.7 - mills on the
dollar, -

7th That the sum of \$304.50 is hereby levied
upon and shall be collected from all
rateable property within an ~~area~~ area
known as a lighting area for the
Hamlet of Beachburg for the
year 1941 - for the purpose of Street
lighting at a rate of 2.1 - mills
on the dollar, -

8th That the sum of \$154.00 is hereby
