

Beachburg March 11, 1959

The council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg met on the above date in the Township Hall. Those present were Reeve J. S. Harris and Councillors A. Gnoise, B. W. Ross and W. A. Burnett.

Minutes of the February meetings were read and adopted and current correspondence and Bills were read and considered.

Edwin C. B. Foster and Lyle Burgess representing the Beachburg Lions Club met council with regard to C.N.R. signal lights in the village.

Moved by B. W. Ross and Arthur Gnoise that this council make application to the Board of Transport Commissioners to have automatic signals erected at the railway crossing at the east entrance to the village of Beachburg on the Main Street on the County Road. Carried.

Moved by W. A. Burnett and Arthur Gnoise that this council accept Mr. Percy Brown's offer to assess the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg for Rolls of 1959 and 1960 at the rate of 200% plus postage on the 1959 Roll. Carried.

The assessor Mr. Brown attended the meeting and agreed to allow the council to pick out a reasonable number of properties that appear to be improperly assessed and a new assessment would be made on these properties as a check on the overall assessment for the 1960 Roll.

Moved by W. A. Burnett and Arthur Gnoise that he write the Fire Marshal to call and inspect the Orange Hall and the Public School #7 re: fire escapes. Carried.

Moved by B. W. Ross and W. A. Burnett that this council grant the request that a Union School Section be formed of the Village of Beachburg and the School section 7 Westmeath. Also that Wm. Reynolds be appointed arbitrator for the village.

Moved by W. A. Burnett and Arthur Gniere that the clerk write a letter to the County Engineer re snow plowing of the streets. Carried.
