County, Village streets, street lights, schools, grants and all purposes for the Village of Beachburg for the year 1960.

Moved by W.P. Burnett and Mr. Jean Rollins that the By-Law to assess and levy rates and taxes for County, village streets, street lights, schools, grants and all purposes for the Village of Beachburg for the year 1960 be read a first time.

Moved by Jean Rollins and Arthur Thuse that the By-Law to assess and levy rates and taxes for County, village streets, street lights, schools, grants and all purposes for the Village of Beachburg for the year 1960 have the blanks filled in as follows.

(1) That the sum of (\$5,258.51) be levied upon and collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg at a rate of 15 Mills on the dollar <sup>for County Purposes</sup>.

(2) That the sum of (\$3,322.08) be levied upon and collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg for Pembroke and District High School Board at a rate of 9.5 Mills on the dollar.

(3) That the sum of (\$9,377.50) be levied upon and collected from all rateable property within the Beachburg Waterworks Area for the Beachburg Waterworks Debenture at a rate of 27.5 Mills on the dollar.

(5) That the sum of (\$690.48) be levied upon and collected from all rateable property within the Beachburg Lighting Area for street lighting at a rate of 2 Mills on the dollar.

(6) And further that a rate of 21.8 mills on the dollar shall be levied upon and collected from all rateable property in the Village of Beachburg for Justice Levy for the year 1960, and be now read a second and third time short and passed.
