Moved by Mrs Jean Rollins and Arthur Guss that a By-Law, prohibiting and regulating the running at large of dogs and seizing and impounding and for killing, whether before or after the impounding dogs running at large, contrary to the By-Law. The purpose of this section a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in a highway or other public place and not under the control of any person, be now introduced, read a first time.

Moved by J.A. Burnett and Mrs Jean Rollins that the By-Law prohibiting and regulating the running at large of dogs and seizing and impounding and for killing whether before or after the impounding dogs running at large, contrary to the By-Law, the purpose of this section a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in a highway or other public place and not under the control of any person. The penalty for impounding such dogs will be 2 dollars plus 50¢ per day board for a period of 4 days. If said dog is not claimed before the end of four days the dog will be destroyed. Be now read a second and third time short and passed. Carried.

Moved by Mrs Jean Rollins and J.A. Burnett that the sum of \$2.00 be paid to H.R. Severin per dog impounded according to By-Law #106. H.R. Severin came to council to discuss his duties as dog catcher for the Village of Beachburg.
