Mrs. Jean Rollins gives notice of a By-Law to assess and levy rates and taxes for County, Village streets, street lights, schools, and all other purposes for the Village of Beachburg for the year 1962.

Moved by Mrs. Jean Rollins and B. W. Ross that the By-Law to assess and levy rates and taxes for the County, Village streets, street lights, schools and all other purposes for the Village of Beachburg for the year 1962 be now introduced and read a first time.

Moved by A. P. Burnett and Arthur Thiese that the By-Law to assess and levy rates for taxes for County, Village streets, street lights, schools and all other purposes for the Village of Beachburg have the blanks filled in as follows:

+ Levy

(1) That the sum of (\$4,456.63) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg for County purposes for the year 1962 at the rate of (12.7) mills on the dollar.

(2) That the sum of (\$5,247.03) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg for the purpose of the Pembroke & District High School Board, for the year 1962, at the rate of (14.9) mills on the dollar.

(3) That the sum of (\$476.17) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg for the purpose of the Unemployment debt to the Town of Pembroke for the High School District Board in 1962, at the rate of (11.35) mills on the dollar.

(4) that the sum of (\$8,952.50) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Beadling Waterworks Area, for the purpose of the Beadling Waterworks Adventure, for the year 1962, at the rate of (27) mills on the dollar.

(5) that the sum of (\$4,695.00) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beadling for General Purposes for the year 1962, at the rates of (13.3) mills on the dollar commercial and (7.6) mills on the dollar residential.

(6) that the sum of (\$533.88) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within an area known as Beadling Lighting and for the purpose of street lighting for the year 1962, at the rate of (2) mills on the dollar.

(7) and further be enacted that the sum of (\$8033.06) shall be levied upon all rateable property within the Village of Beadling for the Trustee levy of the Beadling Public School Section No 7 at the rates of (24.8) ^{mills on the dollar} commercial and (22.3) mills on the dollar residential.
