Those taking this "Oath of members of Court of Revision" were, B.W. Ross, T.S. Harris, Mrs Jean Rollins, Arthur Thiese and A.P. Burnett.

First Appeal considered was of Roll No 177 by Mrs E. Stokes who was present. It was moved by T.S. Harris and Arthur Thiese that Mrs Stokes' assessment Roll No 177 be sustained. Carried.

Mr. Allen Singleton appeared before the Court without written appeal but verbally requested his commercial assessment be changed to residential since he would no longer operate business of Nov 30/62. Moved by A.P. Burnett and T.S. Harris that Mr. Singleton's assessment on Roll # 173 be left as is,

due to the fact the proper procedure was not followed with respect to the appeal. Carried.

Mr. Joseph Bromley appealing the assessment of Roll # 25 Re estate of John A. Brown was unable to be present. A letter from him was read by the Clerk to the Court. Moved by Mrs. Jean Rollins and Arthur Thiese that the property on roll No. 25, remain at the same assessment. Carried.

An appeal to assessment on Roll no 143 was submitted by Mr. John Lavelle. Mr. Lavelle was not present. Moved by T.S. Harris and W.A. Burnett that the assessment on the Orange Hill Roll number 143 be sustained. Carried.

A letter from Mr. Donald Connelly was read to Court. The assessor Mr. Herb Ross was asked to look again at this property of Mr. Connelly's which he was asking for reduction of 1962 taxes.
