read and approved.

A letter from Dr. A. P. Whittage M.D. H. was read to council which stated his intentions with council agreement, to hold clinics for inoculations at a fee of \$1.00 each. Dr. Whittage was carried into the meeting of council and following the discussion of each others responsibility concerning such a clinic, it was decided by council to set this matter aside for present.

Mr. Earl Bawn Building Inspector came to council to ask if services such as road, water and Hygiene could be extended to lots at the south end of Monte street, immediately adjacent to property belonging to Mr. R. S. Cassiday. He was assured that council would attend to these matters as soon as it was certain that this property would be occupied.

It was moved by W. A. Burnett and Arthur Thiese that this council borrow ten thousand dollars, using Stateworks bonds as security, from the Bank of Nova Scotia Bechburg. Carried.

Arthur Thiese. W. A. Burnett gives notice of a By-Law to assess and levy rates and taxes for County, Village, Streets, street lights, schools and all other purposes for the Village for the year 1963. Moved by Arthur Thiese and W. A. Burnett that the By-Law to assess and levy rates for the Village of Bechburg for the year 1963 be now introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Arthur Thiese and W. A. Burnett that the By-Law to assess and levy rates for taxes for County, Village, streets, street lights, schools and all

other purposes for the Village of Beaulieu for the year 1963 have the blanks filled in as follows.

(1) That the sum of (\$4,661.99) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beaulieu for County Purposes for the year 1963 at the rate of 12.8 mills on the dollar.

(2) That sum of (\$7022.07) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beaulieu for the purpose of providing \$2,978.15 for the Pembroke Collegiate Institute and \$3,609.57 for the Champlain Secondary School and \$434.35 to the Town of Pembroke for the purpose of the high school debt at the rate of 20.9 mills on the dollar commercial and 18.9 mills on the dollar residential.

(3) That the sum of (\$9,740.00) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Beaulieu Waterworks Area, for the purpose of the Beaulieu Waterworks Debentures, for the year 1963, at the rate of 27 mills on the dollar.

(4) That the sum of (\$5,700.00) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the Village of Beaulieu for general purposes for the year 1963, at the rate of 15.6 mills on the dollar commercial and 10.1 mills on the dollar residential.

(5) That the sum of (\$842.32) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within an area known as the Beaulieu Lighting Area for the purpose of street lighting for the year 1963, at the rate of 2.45 mills on the dollar.

(6) and further be it enacted that the

following sum of \$8288.00 shall be levied upon all rateable property within the Village of Beachburg for the Trustee levy of the Beachburg Public School and Union School section number 7 Westmeath at the rate of

24.7 mills on the dollar commercial and 22.2 mills on the dollar residential.
