Meeting was called to order by Reeve T.S. Harris. Present were councillors R.V. Daugherty, W.H. Campbell & W.A. Burnett. Councillor B.W. Ross entered meeting at 8:20 p.m.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Correspondence presented.

(1) From E.M. Brown county clerk, enquiring what council's intention is to using the available centennial grant.

Moved by R.V. Daugherty and B.W. Ross  
 that the By-Law to assess and levy rates for  
 the village of Beacleving for the year 1964  
 be now introduced and read a first time.

Moved by B.A. Ross and R.V. Daugherty  
 that the By-Law to assess and levy rates for  
 taxes for county purposes, village streets,  
 streetlights, schools and all other purposes for  
 the village of Beacleving for the year 1964  
 have the blanks filled in as follows.

(1) That the sum of (\$5,581.93) is hereby  
 levied upon and shall be collected from  
 all rateable property within the village of  
 Beacleving for county purposes for the year 1964  
 at the rate of (15) mills on the dollar.

(2) That the sum of (\$7,130.16) is hereby  
 levied upon and shall be collected from  
 all rateable property within the village of  
 Beacleving for the purposes of providing  
 \$3,651.35 for Pembroke Collegiate Institute  
 \$3,039.48 for Champlain Secondary School  
 \$439.33 to the Town of Pembroke (High school  
 debt) at the rate of (20.9) mills on  
 the dollar commercial and at the rate of  
 18.9 mills on the dollar residential.

(3) That the sum of (\$9,485.00) is hereby  
 levied upon and shall be collected from  
 all rateable property within the area known  
 as the Beacleving Waterworks Area for the  
 purpose of the Beacleving Waterworks

(4) that the sum of (\$ 8,025.22) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beachburg for general purposes for the year 1964 at the rate of (21.6) mills on the dollar commercial and (16.2) mills on the dollar residential.

(5) that the sum of (\$ 916.54) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Beachburg Lighting Area for the purpose of street lighting for the year 1964, at the rate of (2.61) mills on the dollar.

(6) and further be it enacted that the sum of (\$ 4,209.53) shall be levied upon all rateable property within the village of Beachburg for the trustee levy of the Public School Board of the Beachburg and Westmead School Area at the rate of (12.4) mills on the dollar commercial and (11.2) mills on the dollar residential, be now read a second and third time that, numbered and passed. Carried.
