Moved by Stephen H. Campbell & P.V. Dauphiny that the by-law to levy rates for the village of Beackling for the year 1967 be now introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Stephen H. Campbell and P.V. Dauphiny that the by-law to assess and levy rates for the year 1967 until the blanks filled in as follows:

No 259 To Assess & Levy Rates

① That the sum of \$6,466.05 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beackling for county purposes for the year 1967 at the rate of (13.7) mills on the dollar.

② That the sum of \$10,926.46 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beackling for the purpose of providing \$4,444.44 for the Pembroke Collegiate Institute and \$6,047.22 for Champlain Secondary School and \$435.78 to the Town of Pembroke as our high school debt due at the rate of (29) mills on the dollar commercial and (26) mills on the dollar residential.

③ That the sum of \$9,677.58 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Beackling Hamlets Area for the purpose of the Beackling Hamlets Telephone for the year 1967 at the rate of (23.6) mills on the dollar.

④ That the sum of \$7,427.36 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beackling for general purposes for the year 1967 at the rate of (18) mills on the dollar commercial and (11) mills

on the dollar residential.

(5) That the sum of \$1,516.27 is levied
levied upon and shall be collected from
all rateable property within the area
known as the Beckbury Lighting Area
for the purpose of street lighting for the
year 1967 at the rate of $\$1(3\frac{1}{2})$ mills
on the dollar.
