① That the sum of (\$6,466.03) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beachburg for county purposes for the year 1967 at the rate of (13.7) mills on the dollar.

② That the sum of (\$10,926.46) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beachburg for the purpose of providing (\$4,441.46) for the Pembroke Cooperative Institute and (\$6,049.22) for Champlain Secondary School and (\$435.78) to the Town of Pembroke as our high school debt at the rate of (29) mills on the dollar commercial and (28) mills on the dollar residential.

③ That the sum of (\$9,677.58) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Beachburg Waterworks Area for the purpose of the Beachburg Waterworks Maintenance for the year 1967 at the rate of (23.6) mills on the dollar.

④ That the sum of (\$7,427.36) is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the village of Beachburg for general purposes for the year 1967 at the rate of (18) mills on the dollar commercial and (11) mills

on the Dallas residential.

⑤ That the sum of \$1,516.27 is levied upon and shall be collected from all rateable property within the area known as the Becklun Lighting Area for the purpose of street lighting for the year 1967 at the rate of (319) mills on the dollar.

⑥ and further be it enacted that the following sum of (\$6,237.59) shall be levied upon all rateable property within the message of Becklun to provide trustee fees of (\$5,926.06) for the Westmeath & Stafford T.S.D. Board and \$240.00 to the Schellhart School for Retarded children and (\$77.33) to the Trust of Westmeath for Public School Delinquent Debt at the rate of (~~17.0~~^{11.0}) mills on the dollar commercial and (~~14.9~~^{11.0}) mills on the dollar residential.
