June 1, 1994

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg met on the above date at the Municipal Office.

Reeve Jamieson called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m., with everyone present.

- The cutting of the grass at the fair Grounds. 1.
- The sidewalk beside the Freshmart. It was decided to have Greg see if he could fill 2. the holes with cold patch.
- Martin Vereyken asked the Village to give back the 20' right-of-way which he had 3. given to the Village as an emergency exit from Vera Crescent. Council decided they would not give this back until Mr. Vereyken has completed the complete circle of roadway on Vera Crescent since an emergency exit is still needed.
- Drainage problems at Kerry McLeese's property and Roy Lemaire's lots were discussed. 4. It was decided to apply for an Infrastructure grant for these. Mr. Leo Regier from the Recreation Committee and Mr. Bob Farnell and Mr. Barry Stephen arrived to discuss the grasss cutting at the Fair Grounds. It was decided that for this year the Village would continue to cut all of the grass but Council asked the N.R.A.S. to help pay the employee's wages. It was decided to not do as much trimming and for next year the two organizations should try to raise enough money to purchase a lawnmower.
- The planting of trees along Main Street was discussed and it was decided that Councillors Wright and DeWal should look after this.
- It was decided to meet again Monday evening, if possible, to review the applications 6. received for the new full-time position which was advertised and to view the drainage problems at McLeese's and Lemaires and also to view ditching, etc. along Vera Crescent.

Moved by Beulah Wright and seconded by Jacob DeWal that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby authorize the Reeve and Clerk to apply for a Canada/Ontario Infrastructure Grant for Waterworks Improvements in the amount of \$45000.00. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned at 11:45 p.m.
