

August 9, 1994

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg met on the above date at the Municipal Office.

Reeve Jamieson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., with Councillors Beulah Wright and Jim Labow present. Councillors DeWal and Somerville arrived later. Mrs. Marie Zettler from the Cobden Sun also arrived.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Beulah Wright that the minutes be adopted as circulated. Carried.

CORRESPONDENCE PRESENTED:

1. There was one construction permit issued to Mr. Roy Lemaire to construct a dwelling valued at \$90,000.
2. From Vance Bedore, County of Renfrew, Parts 1 and 3, Bill 163 and the Ontario Planning and Development Act, 1994 and the Comprehensive set of policy statements and a letter asking Council to endorse the enclosed brief or formulate their own brief.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Jacob DeWal that the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg endorse the brief formulated by the County of Renfrew and submitted to the Provincial Government concerning proposed changes to the Ontario Planning Act. Carried.

3. From Kevin Mooder, Greer, Galloway, a copy of a letter which he had sent to Remisz & Associates, who are the engineers for Mr. Martin Vereyken, regarding Council's concerns regarding the subdivision at Vera Crescent and Cameron Streets. And also a copy of the reply sent to Mr. Mooder from Remisz & Associates.

The Clerk stated that Recreation would like to apply for an Infrastructure Grant build on to the Zamboni Room at the Arena and to replace the back doors and insulate the roof of the zamboni room.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Jacob DeWal that the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby authorize the Reeve and Clerk to apply for an Infrastructure Grant for improvements and renovations to the Beachburg Arena at an estimated cost of \$38,950.00. Carried.

Moved by Beulah Wright and seconded by Jim Labow that a by-law to amend by-law No. 657 be received and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Beulah Wright that a by-law to amend By-Law No. 657 be read a second time and be referred to a committee of the whole Council. Carried.

Moved by Jacob DeWal and seconded by Jim Labow that a by-law to amend by-law 657 to read - Secondary Separate School Mill Rate -83.567 mills as reported by the Committee of the Whole be read a third time, passed and numbered 665 and that the said by-law be signed by the Reeve and clerk, sealed with the seal of the Corporation, and be engrossed in the By-Law Book. Carried.


Discussions:

1. The Vereyken Subdivision at the end of Cameron Street was discussed and upon the advice of solicitor Del O'Brien it was decided not to return the access road (Block K) to Mr. Vereyken, since there is not another access road out of the subdivision. Councillor Labow also thought the Village should get easements from Mr. Vereyken for the ditches at the back of the lots. Council also decided to have Mr. O'Brien send a letter to Mr. Vereyken asking him to construct an access road.
2. Drainage problems were discussed at Mr. Clem White's and Mr. Bill Selles.
3. Councillor Labow asked Council to think about the proposed Nuclear Waste Depot at Deep River.
4. It was decided to supply Mr. David Chevalier of the Township of Westmeath with water if he pays the full amount of building the line.
5. It was decided to allow Greg and Shane to purchase a battery packed drill and a set of cutting torches.
6. It was also decided that Greg and Shane should look after the Water Treatment Plant and that the services of Mr. Murray Anderson would no longer be required.

Moved by Grant Somerville and seconded by Jim Labow that this meeting of the Council of the Village of Beachburg hereby adjourn until September 13, 1994.
