Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Beulah Wright that the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg enter into a contract for Waste Disposal for a 4 month period from January 1 to April 30/95 with Laidlaw Waste Disposal. Carried. The Reeve and Clerk then signed the agreement.

From the Renfrew County Clerks & Treasurers Association, an ivitation to the Clerk and all members of Council to attend the quartierly meeting of the Association in Barry's Bay, which is also the Christmas meeting. Each clerk is to receive aCertificate of Recognition.

4. From the Township of Bagot & Blythfield a resolution regarding asking the County of Renfrew to examine the Bedminster Group as an option to a Waste Management Site.

5. From the Townships of Stafford and Pembroke, a motions regarding the transporting of low-level Waste Management across Renfrew County and objecting to it.

6. From Sean Conway, M.P.P. a letter congratulating Reeve Jamieson and all members of Council on their elections to Council.

That any of the above-mentioned officers is hereby authorized for and in the name of the Corporation to endorse and transfer to the Bank for deposit or discount with or collection by the Bank, cheques, promissory notes, bills of exchange, orders for the payment of money and other instruments, to arrange, settle, balance and certify all books and accounts with the Bank and to sign receipts for vouchers.
