

November 14, 1995

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg met on the above date at the Municipal Office.

Reeve Jamieson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., with everyone present except Councillor Somerville, who arrived later. Also present was Marie Zettler from the Cobden Sun.

Moved by Beulah Wright and seconded by Jim Labow that the minutes be adopted as circulated. Carried.

CORRESPONDENCE PRESENTED

1. There was one building permit issued to Mr. Ron Lowe to construct a car wash and mini storage, valued at \$44,000.00.
2. From the Village of Petawawa, notice of a low level radioactive waste meeting to be held on November 23, 1995.
3. From the Beachburg Fire Dept., a letter asking Council to put a float in the parade, which is being held on December 2, 1995.
4. From the Township of Stafford, 2 resolutions passed by Council regarding Waste Management.
5. From the Ontario Society for the prevention of Cruelty to Animals, copies of the agreement to be signed at the same rates as we are now paying. The contract would extend to include January 1, 1995 to December 31, 1995. The Reeve and Clerk signed the agreement.
6. From the Pembroke & Area Waste Management Board, a copy of a by-law they would like drawn up, pertaining to the Compensation Policy to be negotiated with owners and tennants, etc..

Moved by Beulah Wright and seconded by Ron Lowe that a by-law to approve the Compensation Policy Ratification be received and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Ron Lowe and seconded by Beulah Wright that a by-law to approve the Compensation Policy Ratification by the Pembroke & Area Waste Management Board be read a second time and be referred to a Committee of the whole Council. Carried.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Beulah Wright that a by-law to approve of the Compensation Policy Ratification by the Pembroke & Area Waste Management Board as reported by the Committee of the Whole be read a third time, passed and numbered 684 and that the said by-law be signed by the Reeve and clerk, sealed with the seal of the Corporation, and be engrossed in the By-Law Book. Carried.

7. From the Township of Wilberforce and from D. Sutherland and S. Davis, letters regarding Waste Management.

Mr. Gordon White arrived at Council and also a delegation from the Township of Wilberforce, with spokesperson Mary Olsen. They want Council to seriously consider using the Bedminster System as a way to get rid of Waste. They also wanted to warn Council that they were seriously thinking of suing the Waste Managment Board and that Council would be Council would be responsible. They left at 8:30 p.m.

Moved by Jim Labow and seconded by Ron Lowe that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby petition M.T.O. for subsidy on Expenditures of \$60, 947.08. Carried.
