

Aug.13, 1996

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg met on the above date at the Municipal Office.

In the absence of the Reeve, the Clerk called the meeting to order with Councillors Ron Lowe, Beulah Wright and Grant Somerville present.

Moved by Grant Somerville and seconded by Ron Lowe that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby appoint Beulah Wright as Reeve Pro Tem. Carried.

Moved by Ron Lowe and seconded by Grant Somerville that the minutes be adopted as circulated. Carried. Mrs. Marie Zettler arrived at Council.

Correspondence Presented:

1. A Thank you card from Judy & Greg Davidson for a gift basket received from Council at the Grand Opening of their flower and gift shop.
2. From Bob Howard, Renfrew/Nipissing/Pembroke Liberals, an invitation to attend a summer picnic on August 15 at CFB Petawawa Yacht Club.
3. From M.T.O., a letter stating that Dave Norlock had been reassigned as Maintenance Supervisor for all of the District of Kingston and that Ms. Joan Williams had been assigned the position of Senior Municipal Supervisor for this area.
4. From the County of Renfrew and the Canadian Salt Company, letters regarding purchasing winter salt. It was decided to ask Greg to see if we could get the same deal from the Township of Westmeath that we had last year.
5. From Det. Commander Dave Hurteau of the O.P.P., a letter asking Council if they would like a presentation from him, annually. Council agreed that this should be done. Councillor Lowe stated that he would like to see a comparison between Beachburg and other Municipalities.
6. From M. Sullivan & Sons, a proposed contract for 20 years to use the Bedminster bioconversion system, literature and correspondence regarding this system Mr. Sullivan stated that he would be privileged to meet with Council to discuss this. It was agreed to table this information until it is decided what is going to happen with the Pembroke & Area Waste Management Study.
7. From the Pin Connection, two pins which had been made for the Village of Beachburg and a price list.

Moved by Grant Somerville and seconded by Ron Lowe that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby authorize the Clerk to order 100 gold pins. Carried.

8. From Davis Communications, a yearly contract with the fire dept, to be signed by the Reeve and Clerk.

Moved by Grant Somerville and seconded by Ron Lowe that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby authorize the Reeve pro tem and the Clerk to sign an agreement with Davis Communications to operate an alarm system capable of alerting and dispatching the Beachburg Fire Department. Carried.
