Carried.

Moved by Grant Somerville and seconded by Jim Labow that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Beachburg hereby pass a resolution regarding the low level radioactive waste disposal site at Chalk River. Carried.

Moved by Beulah Wright and seconded by Grant Somerville that a resolution be passed supporting the provincial governet int's boycott of the mandatory federal Gun registry. Carried.
