our Fire Bylaw be amended by adding to clause  
3. See 3. the following. That from Apr 15<sup>th</sup> to May 15<sup>th</sup>.  
(inclusive)  
of each year, that open fires may be set, under safe  
guarded conditions, for the purpose of burning up the raking,  
Rubbish, etc of the spring clean up. all fires to be wet down  
and extinguished by sundown of the day set. Carried

Also that all closets must be properly cleaned <sup>contents</sup> and properly  
disposed of at the time and manner as stated by the  
statute.

Council adjourned to meet the first Monday of May - at  
7:30 pm.
