Council asking that our Main St be surfaced from curb to curb as at the present condition ~~every thing on the streets~~ the gravel on the sides and all other street matter is being washed into the drains with danger of blocking them. Carried The hour of 8 to 11 am. on Tuesdays of each week were set to have the power on for washing etc for the convenience of users.
