Constable, Sanitary inspector Painskupper Hall & ground Cantarick assessor, and general village work. Tender to state salary by month. Lower or any tender not necessarily accepted. Carried

Moved by Mr Morrison see Mr Robinson that application for P.P. operator stating salary be tendered for. Motion Not Carried

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr Robinson that the Rev. & Messrs McCready & Morrison be a P.P. Committee. Carried

 of June and 1<sup>st</sup> member or over 10<sup>00</sup> r.h.<sup>00</sup> by all Council.
