Regular meeting of Council on the above date in Memorial Hall. all present.

Minutes of previous meetings were read, approved and signed by the Reeve.

Mr Robt Dunlop appears before Council asking if Council has any objections to his opening a shooting gallery in his rink and the matter was referred to the clerk to look up the statute regarding the matter and report to Council.

A communication from Jas Croymore regarding coal was read.

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr McCreary that any other persons in the village handling coal be asked to tender carriage Messrs Francis Connolly appears before Council as delegate from The Women's Institute requesting permission to place a piano in the basement of Hall and charge a rental for its use. After some discussion Council agreed to give this permission and agreed on a rental of \$1.00 per evening. At dances etc when the charge of Hall is 10.00 the Hall will pay the rental and at all other rentals of less than the 10.00 the person wishing to use the piano will pay the rental.

The Institute assume all responsibility of the piano as to insurance, tuning etc.

Mr Morrison gave notice of a Bylaw for payments
Moved by Mr Morrison see Mr McCreary that Bylaw for payments be read a first time and the Bylaw was read accordingly

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr Robinsons that Bylaw No. 488 the blanks having been filled in be read a second and third time short and passed. Carried.

The placing of the street lights on a switch at front house was discussed and left for later consideration

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr Robinsons that the Fire Bylaw be amended to allow street ^{and yard} burning of spring rubbish for 1931 from Apr 7th to May 10th Carried
