Mr McCarty gave notice of a By-law for payments
 made by Mr McCarty see Mr McKenny that By-law
 for payments be read a first time and the By-law
 was read accordingly

Messrs Phillips & McDonald appeared before Council asking
 for protection on the 12th against street stands near the
 agricultural grounds. and for permission to put up
 one or more banners ~~across~~ across the street; this was
 granted and protection promised.

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr McCarty that wages
 for village labor be reduced to 20¢ per hour Carried
 Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr Robinson that the blockage
 in Barrar or corner of Crawford & Hudson be remedied and
 that a catch basin be put in at the corner of Main and
 Pembroke and the necessary tile be procured for each
Carried

Mr Frazer appears before Council as a delegate from the
 C.A.A.U. asking Council to loan the tennis court
 pupans for use for the season and a net procured.
 and that the C.A.A.U. would be glad to supervise
 the use of it.

Moved by Mr McKenny see Mr Robinson that the
 tennis court be fixed up or procured and the
 C.A.A.U. have supervision of it for the season.
Carried

Council instructs the clerk to notify all persons
 with overdue light bills giving them fifteen days
 to settle & if not done have lights cut off.
