Mr Robinson gave notice of a Bylaw for payments. Moved by Mr Robinson see Mr McCready that Bylaw for payments be read a first time and the Bylaw was read accordingly.

Moved by Mr Robinson see Mr Morrison that open fires for purpose of cleaning up be allowed from Monday Oct 12th 31 for the three weeks following last night between sunrise and sunset all fires to be out at sunset. Carried

The constables hours of duty till further notice were set for, from the time the lights go off to 4 A.M. and on motion of Mr McCready see Mr Robinson, the Revd & Mr Morrison were appointed to have jurisdiction over his duties. Moved Mr McCready see Mr Morrison that Bylaw for payments, the amounts having been filled in the next in second and third time above and passed - carried
Mr. Mr Morrison see Mr Robinson that till further notice begining Monday Oct 12th, power hours be from one pm to 11 pm Daily. Carried
