In the case of the Bell Co re removal of poles. Council decides now to ask for the change as the cost was too much.

Mr Ross gave notice of a Bylaw for payment of accounts. Moved by Mr Ross see Mr Morris that the Bylaw be read a first time and the Bylaw was read accordingly. Moved by Mr McCurdy see D'Ritchie that Bylaw be read for payment the blanks having been filed in Council a second and third time and passed. Carried

Moved by D'Ritchie see Mr Morris that 9 men Ross McCurdy individed all those who are 4 mos or more in arrear with their light bills with the proposal that the bill for the last 2 months plus 10% of further arrears be paid by the first of April and each remaining after that plus 10% of arrears and so on till all arrears are paid. Or otherwise power will be discontinued

Mr McCurdy see D'Ritchie that information be put out to the owners of license in force generally in other villages for the sale of cigarettes for the next meeting of Council.

Moved by D'Ritchie see Mr Ross that, coming to the fire Bylaw, open fires may be set for cleaning up purposes, under proper supervision and in proper places for this year, from March 1st to May 1st
