Meeting of Council on the above date in  
 Municipal Hall. All present  
 Minutes of previous meeting were read, approved  
 and signed by the Reeve  
 Mr. Brown appeared before council asking for a part  
 time city engineer  
 Mr. Wall was present to point out to Council the need of some  
 repairs to the Power House  
 Mr. Morris gave notice of a By Law for payments  
 of Rates gave notice of a By Law for Licensing - a  
 vote on Hydrant power.  
 Mr. Marriotte being present asked for an improvement  
 in the surface drainage around his property  
 Mr. Hawkins asked that Curfew be again put in force.  
 Mr. DeRicheu see Mr. Morris that Constable Boyle ring  
 Curfew each night at nine p.m. beginning Sept 1<sup>st</sup>/34 and  
 Curfew to apply to all children up to 16 yrs of age. Carried  
 Mr. DeRicheu see Mr. Lalor that Mr. Brown be issued a  
 city license at 10<sup>00</sup> but be refunded \$2 for the 1/2 year. Carried  
 Mr. DeRicheu see Mr. Lalor that if the Institute desire the  
 Hall as a room for winter agricultural classes that the price  
 be \$200 a month. The Institute to supply their own heating and be  
 responsible for any damage incurred by the class. Carried  
 Mr. W. Ross see DeRicheu that Ream Ross see about the  
 repairs necessary to Brown's Bridge over the creek. Carried  
 The street committee agreed to look into Mr. Marriotte's complaint.  
 Mr. Mr. Morris see Mr. Lalor that by-law for payments  
 be read a few times and the By Law was read  
 accordingly  
 Mr. Mr. A. Ross see DeRicheu that By-law<sup>542</sup> for payments  
 the blanks having been filled in be read a second and  
 third time and passed Carried  
 Mr. DeRicheu see Mr. Morris that By-law No 543 for Licensing  
 a vote on Hydrant be read a few times and the By Law  
 was read accordingly  
 Mr. Mr. Lalor see Mr. A. Ross that By-law No. 545 be  
 read a second and third time and passed  
 Carried.  
 Mr. C. Craig was present to ask for removal of pole  
 Mr. Boyle ask council for sweets loan of atones starting with  
 part of August. agreed to.
