

Cooden May 7 - 35

Regular meeting of Council on the above date in Memorial Hall. Present all Councillors present. Minutes of previous meeting were read, approved and signed by the Reeve.

Communication from the Co. Treasurer asked for a payment of C. arrears on the G. R. levy.

Moved by Mr. A. Ross sec. D. Ritchie that one thousand dollars on a/c be sent to the County. Carried

Mr. R. W. Ross appeared before Council asking that some repairs be made on Ross St.

The condition of the streets in general was discussed and the street committee will look them over & report on what's needed.

Mr. Lalonde reports on the Council House which is rented to J. Dapina and moved seconded by Mr. Morris that Mr. Dapina be allowed two months rent for the cleaning up of the property. Carried

Moved by Mr. Lalonde sec. Mr. A. Ross that rents as follows be charged to the tenants of the following properties which have become village property through the recent tax sale. Tenants to be so notified and rent to become payable from May 1st 1935 -

The clerk was instructed to have one wire run the second wire down main st. as formerly agreed and to replace a pole serving the creamery.

Moved by Mr. Morris sec. Mr. Lalonde that By-law for payments be read a first time and the By-law was read accordingly.

Moved by D. Ritchie sec. Mr. A. Ross that By-law 1155 for payments the blanks having been filled in be read a second and third time short and passed. Carried

Council agreed to meet at 8 P.M. instead of 7⁰⁰ for the summer months. Council adjourns
