 later in the spring a fireman's ball
 be held, the proceeds to be used for
 the purchasing of rubber boots, coats and
 hats to be used by members of the
 fire brigade.

 at the next council meeting.

 for the condition of the fire wells and
 is in order to have them in condition

for emergency use.
