we were able to have 4 tons of Calc. Chloride as soon as possible.
Council decided that there should be no more ball playing
on the Hall grounds, and that Sunday ball playing in the
municipality will not be tolerated.

The clerk was instructed to have a notice in this week's paper
that any dog tax or poll tax not paid by June 14/41 will
be placed in Court for collection.
