Correspondence was read from the Dept. of Munic. Affairs Re-assessment, C.P.R. Re pipe crossing, Bill Cuyke Pole attachments, & R.R. Tax distributions.

By Agreement of Council, wages for ordinary Labor for 1942 was set at 30¢ per hour.

Motion by Mr. Lester Sec. D. MacKechnie that By-laws for payments be read a first time and the By-laws were read accordingly.

Motion by Mr. Lester Sec. D. MacKechnie that By-laws No 689 for payments the blanks having been filled in be read a second and third time short and passed.

Motion by Mr. Lester Sec. D. MacKechnie that Council start a movement tomorrow getting up a petition to the Provincial Government asking to have Calden made a centre for the issuance of motor vehicle licenses as the present system entails a lot of expense and trouble on the people of this community.
