

Colborne Aug 10/42

Regular meeting of Council in Mem. Hall on above date. Present Revere Collins and all Councillors. The minutes of previous meeting were read, approved, and signed by the Reeve.

Cecil Wall was present to inform Council that he had joined up in the forces and had to be in Ottawa on Aug 18<sup>th</sup>.

Council expressed appreciation of his services and assured him his work was open to him on his return.

The Clerk was directed by Council to ask the authorities to grant him leave for about 3 weeks at the end of the month to instruct someone in his duties and to arrange his own affairs.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mr Durham to obtain permission for Mr King to do any small line work which may be necessary. Replace lamp, connect services etc.

Mr. Mr Lester see Mr Dack that a new transducer be brought from the Hydros. (as per letter) 1/12<sup>00</sup> Carried.

Moved by Mr Dack see Mr Miller that supplies for the fire engine be purchased for all the different dealers in Colborne and that fire equipment of any kind must be kept in the fire hall and not removed for any use except what it is there for. Carried.

Moved by Mr Mackenzie see Mr Lester that By-law for payments be read a first time and the By-law was read accordingly.

Moved by Mr Miller see Mr Dack that By-law 695 for payments the blanks having been filled in be read a second and third time short and passed. Carried.
