Emergency meeting of Council held in Council chamber. To discuss Fire Protection for ~~the~~ part of Village east of South St.

Present: Rev. Mac Seeger, Councillors: Dr Mac Kersh, Miller, Mershley and later Luchs.

Mr. Mershley - after consulting operators of fire apparatus suggests that a well be placed at Highway + main and a second well further up Highway - a pipeline to pump at lake be installed; said pump to force water to first well or on to well at fire Hall.

Until such a set up can be installed Mr Mershley proposes that several hole cut in ice of lake be kept open.
