 Assessor. 1. John McIntyre, J.P. Police, Collector of Police
 and Dog Tax, along with present job annual salary \$2000.⁰⁰

2. Jack Russell, Police Assessor, and Collector, Salary \$1600.⁰⁰

3. Mylton Fundergast, Police Assessor, and Collector,
 Salary \$2000. This would include Holidays with pay, one winter
 uniform, one summer uniform, with Rain Coat, and
 over Coat, 2 pr. Boots, a Thirty-eight Call Revolver,
 free telephone, and Eight Cents per mile for truck when
 used for town purposes.

4. Joseph McIntilly, same work @ \$800.⁰⁰ per year and
 cooperate with other working for town.
