Council meeting held in Council Chamber Monday
 Mar. 3 at 8 P.M. Present were Councillors Francis,
 Burgess, Leach and Markley. Mr. Francis took the
 chair in the absence of the Reeve.

Minutes of previous meeting were read.

Correspondence was read.

Mr. Gordon Gibson was present regarding the
 auditor's report on Hydro and the continuation of
 re-building of Cobden Street lighting system. Mr.
 Gibson stated the total billing of Hydro for the
 village for 1951 was \$14,692.75; total costs were
 \$8,074.36 making a return of \$6,618.39 plus \$41.23 lost.

total of \$6,659.57; this amount has been received and credited to the Cobden Hydro account.

Cobden Hydro Current account bal. Feb 29/52 \$9,494.06 and the Savings account \$3,128.76.

The work of rebuilding of village street lights was planned in three stages, one of which is completed. The second stage has been approved by the Provincial Comm. to the amount of \$18,000.00 plus the buying of material by the Comm. and the salvage of old material.

Cobden by taking a higher voltage, direct from the sub-station at McPeak's means a saving to the Commission as they do not have any outlay in capital for a sub-station in the village. On this account the Regional Hydro Office approves of the Cobden setup and are pleased to continue the rebuilding in Cobden at once. Cobden is the only place in Ontario with this approval.

Mr. Francis thanked Mr. Gibson for his report and also for his interest in the village Hydro.
