Moved by J. K. Robinson sec by G. A. Wallace
that this Council, at the request of the
Public School Board of the Village of Golden,
and in accordance with the approval
expressed by the majority of Public School
Supporters in the recent vote on the question
of building a new Public School, endorse and
approve the project, and that leave be
immediately secured from the Municipal
Board for proceeding with the erection of
a new five class - room Public School
at a cost of up to \$90,000⁰⁰ and for
issuing debentures to cover cost of same
carried
